

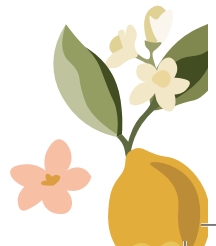


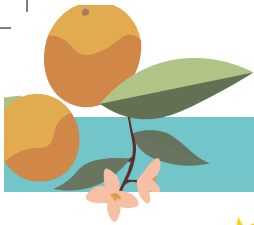
## "You're my Love"

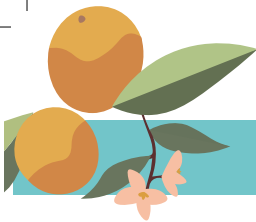
Our Spring celebrations and events seek to both celebrate our village of support and also to develop new partnerships and donor support each year, through the matched giving program,

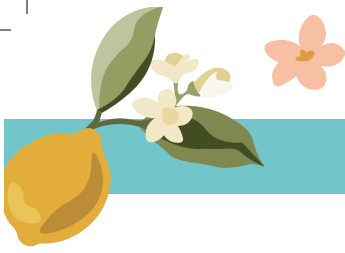
